Taking time to see if a CCA would provide ample rate savings is something the City of Huntington Beach should strongly consider. Measures such as the CCA allow for a more competitive field when looking to recruit employers and jobs to Huntington Beach.

Permitting the signature of the non-disclosure agreement with Southern California Edison in no way obligates the City to develop a CCA, it merely provides adequate access to data. Exploring the possibility of a CCA without this data would be impossible or at best incomplete.
